Under certain conditions, elementary students may "reach ahead" to take secondary school courses. The principal of a student's elementary school and/or the principal of a secondary school may decide, with parental consent, that it is appropriate for the student to enroll in one or more secondary courses. Upon entering grade 9, the principal of the secondary school assumes responsibility for recording the student's achievement and granting credits.
